WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No. 1, Township of Burlington, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, noticed and held a public hearing pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-78.2 on the proposed annual budget for fiscal year 2026, from January 1, 2026, to December 31, 2026, on January 8, 2026, hereinafter referenced as the “annual budget”; and

WHEREAS, the annual budget has been presented for adoption before the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No. 1, Township of Burlington, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, at its noticed public meeting held on January 8, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the annual budget as presented for adoption reflects each item of revenue and appropriation in the same amount and title as set forth in the introduced and approved budget, including all amendments thereto, if any, which have been approved by the State of New Jersey, Department of Community Affairs, Director of the Division of Local Government Services; and

WHEREAS, the adopted budget is in compliance with the Property Tax Levy Cap Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.44, et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the annual budget as presented for adoption reflects total revenues of \$4,024,049.00 which includes the amount to be raised by taxation of \$2,971,000.00 and total appropriations of \$4,024,049.00; and

WHEREAS, an election shall be held on February 21, 2026, to determine the amount of money to be raised by taxation for the ensuing year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No. 1, Township of Burlington, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that at its noticed public meeting held on January 8, 2026, the annual budget of Fire District No. 1 for fiscal year beginning January 1, 2026, and ending December 31, 2026, be and is hereby adopted and shall constitute appropriations for the purposes stated and authorization of total revenues of \$4,024,049.00 which includes the amount to be raised by taxation of \$2,971,000.00 and total appropriations of \$4,024,049.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the annual budget as presented for adoption reflects each item of revenue and appropriation in the same amount and title as set forth in the introduced and approved budget, including all amendments thereto, if any, which have been approved by the

State of New Jersey, Department of Community Affairs, Director of the Division of Local Government Services; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the District shall hold an annual election on February 21, 2026, to determine the amount of money to be raised by taxation for the ensuing year; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the results of the annual budget election be certified to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services and the Township of Burlington Tax Assessor; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the 2026 adopted budget for fiscal year 2026 be attached to this Resolution and made a part hereof; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board Clerk be authorized to forward the annual adopted budget to the State of New Jersey, Department of Community Affairs, Director of the Division of Local Government Services, for its adoption; and



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE BURLINGTON TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE BURLINGTON TOWNSHIP OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FOR THE UTILIZATION OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT'S UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No. 1, Township of Burlington, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, in an effort to enhance interagency cooperation and improve emergency response capabilities through the shared use of technology, has agreed to allow the Burlington Township Police Department and the Burlington Township Office of Emergency Management to utilize the Fire Department's Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) for emergency response and training purposes; and

WHEREAS, it has been agreed to by and between the parties that a Memorandum of Understanding shall be prepared to establish the terms and conditions under which the Fire Department's Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) may be utilized for said emergency response and training purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No. 1, Township of Burlington, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Burlington Township Police Department and the Burlington Township Office of Emergency Management, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, for the shared use of technology as set forth above; and

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE INTENT TO USE AN ALTERNATE
PROCUREMENT METHOD PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2(B)(3)**

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No. 1, Township of Burlington, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, is established and operating pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-70 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, in all matters of procurement, the Board is mandated to comply with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., with the exception of an alternate procurement method as set forth in N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2(b)(3) which permits procurements by entering into nationally recognized cooperative agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Board resolved to join a national cooperative, namely, the Houston-Galveston Area Counsel (HGAC), a regional planning commission and political subdivision of the State of Texas, operating under Chapter 391, Texas Local Government Code, and the Board entered into an agreement thereto without cost or obligation to the Board; and

WHEREAS, prior to using the alternate procurement method, the Board is required pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2(b)(3) to publish notice of its intent to use the alternate procurement method in the Board's official newspaper at least ten (10) days prior to the meeting at which the Board shall consider same and provide a time for public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that it is in the best interest of the District and the community to utilize the HGAC for the procurement of a Pierce Enforcer 107' Ascendant Aerial with necessary equipment to make the emergency response vehicle functional.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No. 1, Township of Burlington, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that it authorize the publication of a notice, in the form attached, informing the public of its intent to use the Houston-Galveston Area Counsel (HGAC) for the procurement of a Pierce Enforcer 107' Ascendant Aerial with necessary equipment to make the emergency response vehicle functional; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such notice shall be published in the Burlington County Times, posted at the municipal building and District Office, forwarded to the Municipal Clerk and posted on the District internet site; and


