Such amount shall be equal to the amount of the total appropriations set forth in the budget minus the total amount surplus and miscellaneous revenues set forth in the budget; and

WHEREAS, in calculating the amount to be raised by taxation, the Fire District has taken into account the assessed valuation of taxable property in the Fire District;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District, at an open public meeting held on December 11, 2025 that the Annual Budget, including all related schedules, of the Fire District for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2026 and ending December 31, 2026 is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the anticipated revenues as reflected in the Annual Budget are of sufficient amount to meet all proposed expenditures/expenses and all covenants, terms and provisions as stipulated in the Fire District's outstanding debt obligations, capital lease arrangements, service contracts, and other pledged agreements; and

Total budgeted appropriations will decrease \$286,604. The decrease is primarily due to decreases in capital appropriations, \$597,000 and debt service, \$89,313. Cost of operations is increasing \$328,296. The amount to be raised by taxation will increase \$181,000.

3. Explain any variances over +/-10% for each line item. Attach in FAST any supporting documentation that will help to explain the reason for the increase/decrease in the budgeted line item. **Be sure to include ALL items for F-2, F-3, and the detail sheets.**

- 1.) Fund balance utilized is decreasing \$522,000 or 49.9%. Unrestricted fund balance of \$525,000 will be utilized in 2026 as compared to \$350,000 utilized in 2025. No restricted fund balance will be utilized in 2026 compared to \$697,000 utilized in 2025 toward the acquisition of a new ladder truck.
- 2.) Total revenues offset with appropriations will increase \$45,950 or 16.5%; the result of an increase in fire prevention programs.
- 3.) Total cost of operations and maintenance will increase \$328,296 or 15.1%; the result of increased staffing.
- 4.) Total appropriations offset with revenue will increase \$45,950 or 16.5%; the result of increased staffing.
- 5.) Capital appropriations will decrease \$597,000. There was a down payment on the ladder truck of \$697,000 in 2025.
- 6.) Debt service will decrease \$89,313. The capital lease on the heavy duty rescue truck was paid off in 2025.
- 7.) Fringe benefits - administration and cost of operations and appropriations offset with revenue are increasing \$7,455 or 10.2% and \$75,296 or 22.4% and \$19,225 or 41.4%, respectively due to increases in PFRS expense and payroll taxes.
- 8.) Administration is increasing \$10,800 or 11.2% due to election - increased costs by County Election Board.
- 9.) Salaries and wages cost of operations and appropriations offset with revenue are increasing \$193,500 or 31.5% and \$24,700 or 14.1% respectively as explained in 3.) and 4.) above.
- 10.) Volunteer incentive program is increasing \$20,000 or 18.2% due to an increase in stipend and expanding the duty crew days of the week.
- 11.) Medical services increase of \$5,000 or 20% increase cost for physicals and cancer screenings.
- 12.) Memberships decrease of \$3,500 or 14.9% decrease annual dinner cost.
- 13.) Fire prevention programs, \$37,450 or 39.3% - increase in staffing and benefits.
- 14.) SOP review and strategic plan projects completed.
- 15.) Computer \$3,000 or 10.5% increase due to switching department to office 365 and emails with cloud back-up.
- 16.) Interest-WSFS Bank increase of \$63.00 or 14.4%. Estimated increase in 2026 earnings
- 17.) Health benefits have increased \$42,872 or 63.9%. Health benefits are not under the state health care plan, they are provided under the Township plan which is self insured. Due to the increase in employees, there is an increase in benefits.

The utilization of unrestricted fund balance will have no impact on the 2027 budget.
